FAO Trees Officers

Having been given further advice, and further to my email sent earlier today, I am giving 5 days notice of a dangerous larch tree overlooking a public footpath on my property.

The loose root plate is lifting the ground surrounding the tree, which leans at an angle of approximately 30 degrees over the footpath. The footpath runs from Crosland Factory Lane uphill towards Woodbottom Road. The tree is a few yards beyond the stone barn, and is clearly marked with blue paint. Because of the nature of the ground, photos do not clearly show the extent of the disruption of the root system, and a visit from you really is essential.

Please let us have a decision soon. The overriding concern is for the safety of members of the public using the footpath.
