<p>Dear Louise Bearcroft,</p> <p>I wish to object to the proposed new housing development at Eastfield, Shepley. I have lived in Shepley for 36 years and greatly value the open green spaces around the edge of this village and at the rear of the First School and along Eastfield. I feel it is important to keep Green Belt areas free from over development, especially for the younger generation.</p> <p>My greatest objection is that the small, narrow residential roads, namely Knowle Park Avenue, Eastfield, and Lea Drive are not suitable to carry hundreds more vehicles on a daily basis, which will happen if the proposed development is approved.</p> <p>Children now living in these streets should be free from heavy construction vehicles outside their homes on a daily basis, which could continue for years.</p> <p>The junction of Lea Drive onto the busy A629 is already a dangerously steep junction, especially in icy conditions and therefore it would be ludicrous to allow hundreds more vehicles to negotiate this particular small junction.</p> <p>Lastly, I want Shepley to continue to be a village and not be forced to become part of an urban sprawl between Huddersfield and Sheffield.</p> <p>Thank you.</p>
