<p>I strongly object to this planning application for the following reasons: ACCESS to and from the site is totally unsuitable and presents many health and safety risks. By sending heavy and increased traffic up Knowle Park Avenue onto Lee Drive through a small housing estate is a recipe for disaster. This is a small estate where many young children play, ride bikes and walk to Shepley First school. This proposal of a one-way system subjects them to significant risks and intolerable inconvenience. The proposed one -way system has the potential to create chaos at peak times and is a non-starter.</p> <p>As residents of Eastfield and now Stonecroft Gardens since 1977 we have experienced and witnessed several near misses as traffic leaves Lea Drive to approach the main A629 down a section of road that has a 1 in 7 gradient. This is extremely dangerous and could easily result in a major road accident especially in snowy and icy conditions. We are often totally unable to get out of our estate despite having a four wheel drive car and snow tyres. In summary ACCESS to and from the sight is enough of a reason to deny this planning application. It is simply DANGEROUS.</p> <p>In addition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Loss of green belt and the flora and fauna that inhabit the sight-Overload on public services, for example, the GP practice, School places (especially in the future)-Damage to already poor road surfaces.-Drainage at the proposed site is another serious concern due to possible contamination of water supplies and water sources- Impact on Shepley Spring meaning a potential loss of jobs for local people <p>Thank you</p>
