<p>Having lived on both Eastfield & Stonecroft Gardens for the past 48 years I object to the proposed housing development on many issues. The basic premise that this takes over a significant area of Green Belt - seriously affecting the environment of the village raises many concerns - there just is no sensible planning base for access and local transport - the locality provides no safe or efficient additional capacity for both development traffic or additional residential traffic. This immediate site access is where young children play, walk to school & where the local school provides cycling proficiency lessons.</p> <p>There are major safety issues with the one way proposal for access from The Knowle through to Lea Drive exit on to the A629 - large articulated lorries, construction traffic will be using this route onto an already steep exit with a 1 in 7 slope - exit will be a "sledge slide" on ice & snow onto the A629 in winter - which it is already!!! Crazy!! There are peak times when these roads are already busy, when parents are taking & meeting children from school. So additional traffic on one way system at exit on Lea Drive/A629 will cause grid lock!!!!</p> <p>Local services already under strain would have real difficulty coping with the additional demand being caused by present developments at Tenterhill Gardens & Tailors Green. Local school places are at near or full capacity. Local shops are not of a number or size to provide for this extra demand - they have no dedicated parking so create real congestion issues already compounded with residential road parking. Shepley already is congested both on the A629 main road, Marsh Lane, Station Road and Jos Lane - all important access routes not just for residents but for the general well being of the environment we presently live in - this proposed development is one step too far!!</p>
