<p>I object to this development,</p> <p>1 Traffic, the scheme as proposed is unworkable, the A629 Knowle entrance is too narrow and carries HG vehicles. In winter vehicles become stranded blocking the access., the exit proposed, the 1/7 down Lea drive becomes impassable due to snow/Ice. It cannot be used because vehicles slide uncontrolled into the 629. Effectively the Knowle estate would become a prison. Lea drive would become a rat run threatening the safety of the many children and older people who live there.</p> <p>2 The proposal threatens the viability of the business known as Shepley Spring, the village cannot afford this business to close because of the employment it provides and the support it gives to the village.</p> <p>3 There are many children living in the village that cannot get access to Shepley school because it is full.</p> <p>4 Local services, schools health and drainage are all overwhelmed. There is insufficient parking available for the business's in the the village and Lea drive becomes dangerously overparked whenever children are being dropped and collected, a serious threat to kiddies walking to and from. There are many cars now parking on the A629 obscuring the sightlines making exiting Lea drive hazardous even in good weather.</p> <p>5 It is very difficult to get a doctors appointment in Shepley, the surgery has too many patients.</p> <p>6 Shepley is now overdeveloped, many additional houses recently added with two significant estates currently being built, both appear to be paused?</p> <p>7 The land earmarked for this proposal delivers a lung to the village and biodiversity which should not be sacrificed.</p> <p>8 The A629 is now overdeveloped with only the greenspace between Shelley & Kirkburton not developed. Transit to Huddersfield now takes twice as long as it did 10 years ago and the road surface is worn out and full of potholes. It is not fit for even more traffic.</p> <p>Thank you</p>
