We are all aware of the frequent accidents up at the Sovereign crossroads. Extra cars will add further to the traffic nightmare on that junction.

The parking outside the Coop is dangerous now. Any more cars will add to that chaos, especially at school time when children need to cross to access their school buses.

I feel that by building on the green belt land surrounding all of the local villages, a dangerous precedent is being set which will ruin the rural nature of the area and Shepley will just turn into Huddersfield urban sprawl.

I'm all in favour of the right number of new houses being built, so that our children can have somewhere to live. Many of the new Shepley houses are way beyond 1st time buyers means, and are presumably just making a lot of money for companies who have no interest in the future of the area.
