<p>I strongly object to the Banks development plans as a resident of Knowle Park Avenue for the following reasons.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* Access to the development is via a small housing estate with narrow unsuitable roads.* A proposed one way south bound street on Knowle Park Avenue would cause endless traffic past our residence.* All traffic would be leaving via Lea Drive. This would be extremely hazardous, the road is far too steep and enters the main road. In winter vehicles avoid this way to exit due to the dangers (snow/ice).* Lea Drive is also used twice a day with the drop off and pick up of children from Shepley First School with high volumes of traffic.* Transport links are poor in the village.* The railway station has no car park so cars block Station Road, this would only get worse* The railway station has steps only on one platform causing issues for anyone with mobility issues.* The bus service is hourly and limited* The sewers are always getting blocked and cannot cope with the volume of houses as it is now.* The co-op is a convenience store not a supermarket. Parking is causing problems now and particularly when the delivery wagons arrive.* Shepley Health Centre is already under pressure to allocate appointments.* Shepley First School is not big enough to accommodate the extra volume of children
