<p>I have lived on Penistone Rd Shelley, near the boundary with Shepley for over 40 years. During that time there has been a large number of extra houses built in both villages. Consequently the volume of traffic on the A629 has multiplied substantially, not just private cars, but delivery vehicles and heavy traffic during the building of new homes. For at least 2 years I was subjected to noise and dust created by the building of Tailors walk at the back of my garden.</p> <p>The increasing volume of traffic has contributed to the collapse of a boundary wall at my property. I would not be happy for even more traffic to compromise the recent &amp; costly repair of this wall.</p> <p>The access road to the site is very narrow for the number of cars involved &amp; it's junction with the A629, an already busy main road, is likely to be problematic with queues forming in all directions.</p> <p>An additional 110 households would place additional pressure on local schools and services, especially doctor's surgeries, which are already oversubscribed. Buses along the A629 directly into Huddersfield are few and far between, meaning more car journeys, congestion and pollution.</p> <p>The proximity of the proposed site to 'Shepley Spring' threatens it's water supply and the existence of a viable local business and employer.</p> <p>The villages of Shelley and Shepley are pleasant places to live in, but they are being spoilt by all the infilling of open fields and 'Green Belt'. Please reject this planning application in the interest of maintaining existing residents quality of life.</p>
