<p>1. Under the green belt rules, I do not feel that this will provide any necessary improvement to local infrastructure.</p> <p>2. The access is not suitable for any increased traffic, firstly the construction traffic, and then the volume of vehicles for 110 houses. Lea Drive is a 1:7 which is dangerous in winter, and the Knowle is used by wagons for Shepley Spring. Both are bad junctions so safety is paramount.</p> <p>3. Safety for children and pedestrians. Shepley First School use the quiet streets for cyclist proficient training so increase in volume of traffic would impede this.</p> <p>4. Shepley Spring, a long standing business, would be threatened by the quality of the water supply.</p> <p>5. Worry about the sewage system not being adequate.</p> <p>6. Transport links - we do not have enough buses or trains, 1 hourly, and parking at the rail station is not sufficient for extra traffic.</p> <p>We do not need any more housing or increased traffic in Shepley.</p>
