<p>Shelley village lies in a green belt area , which is being eroded by housing development, changing it from semi rural to urban overspill, losing valuable farmland. The main road, A629, is an accident black spot and will not cope with extra traffic joining it.</p> <p>Banks states that Shepley has a supermarket, this is not true, the Co-op is a convenience store, and has very limited parking at a busy road junction.</p> <p>The village needs bungalows built, to enable elderly residents to move to smaller properties, and small starter homes, not large 4 or 5 bedroom houses as Banks proposes.</p> <p>Local amenities such as schools, doctors, public transport etc are insufficient for such a large increase in population.</p> <p>My main objection is the detrimental effect the development would have on Shepley Springs, a good local employer, that is family run and has been in existence for 50 years or more.</p>
