**Subject:** Objection to development at Eastfield, Shepley

To whom it may concern.

My name is Woodhead Court, Shepley. I have lived here for over 5 years. I first lived in Shepley in 1982 for 5 years.

I am writing to formally object the planned development at Eastfield, Shepley.

I am beyond shocked that there could be room/facilities for yet a further 110 houses in Shepley particularly on what is classified as 'green belt' land by Banks Group.

There are so many valid reasons as to why I'm so worried about the possibility of more houses in our village.

There has already been a huge amount of houses that have been built on Abbey Road with yet more in the process of being built by Vivly. The continued disruption that that has caused and is still causing is unacceptable.

It is beyond comprehension the further disruption building yet more houses will cause for years. The exit for these houses is planned to be one way through yet another estate dropping down straight onto the Abbey road. So 2 large housing estates feeding directly onto the same main road which already is a very busy road.

The facilities in Shepley will not be able to support these further planned houses. They barely can now! Already trying to get a doctor's appointment at the health centre proves very difficult. And Vivly still are building houses so this will only get worse. The local little Coop is a small corner shop, and has very limited parking. It's already a nightmare.
