<p>This particular application for building many houses adjacent to Eastfield is an unacceptable use of land currently designated as Green Belt. We are already surrounded by numerous new build residential properties and the pressure that this already places on traffic and parking considerations, access for children at Shepley First School, appointments at our doctor's surgery and pharmacy and the safety of all Shepley residents, especially children is in danger of being totally disregarded. Parking in the village is already chaotic near the shops in the centre of the village, up Marsh lane towards the church and down Station Road towards the station and any further residential development, let alone one of potentially up to 110 new homes is a recipe for disaster. Access to and from the proposed site into the main road via either Lea Drive or via The Knowle is a recipe for chaos and more importantly an accident waiting to happen.</p> <p>The Banks Group appear blasé in stating that our village already has a supermarket and that their presence in the village will be a bonus for everyone who lives in Shepley and who works at Shepley Spring.
