<p>My objections to the proposed development are as follows</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Building on greenbelt land causing an adverse impact on wildlife, biodiversity &amp; erosion of green space.</li><li>2. Increased traffic problems within the village caused by an extra 200 cars using already congested roads, along with the use of the "rat-run" through Stones Wood as drivers try to avoid congestion towards Huddersfield.</li><li>3. The proposal to make Lea Drive one way only, causing all traffic to exit the proposed site using a steep incline onto the A629 which is already problematic during icy winter weather.</li><li>4. Oversubscription of Shepley Primary school meaning children would need to travel to other schools further afield by car as public transport is limited.</li><li>5. Inability of local health services ( Dentist , GP surgery etc) to cope with a large influx of new residents.</li><li>6. Lack of reliable public transport</li><li>7. Adverse effects the proposed development would have on the aquifer serving Shepley Spring, a major business employing local people.</li></ol>
