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I am writing to object to the above application on a number of grounds.

I have lived with my family in Shepley since 2014. I live on station road with only on road parking for my car, the parking of cars for the station is already poor, this will further increased with the huge number of houses proposed to use the local train station.

Parking around the shops is terrible and clogs up the exit from the centre of the village, this will be further worsened, we have already seen the impact from extra housing in shepley as every seems to drive to the shops these days.

I have two sons who enjoy cycling around the village, their safety will be impacted by increased traffic and also on the housing estate where they visit friends next to the proposed site.

This proposal threatens to jeopardise Shepley Spring's future of which our village is very proud and provides much support to the local community through initiatives and employment.

The idea of making a one way up to the existing housing estate is dangerous as my sons both wait for the bus on the main abbey road (near the stone bench) and have to take care as lorrys are coming out of this junction, to further clog up the junction with ALL the cars going in this way would be unmanageable.

This land is prime farming land with plenty of wildlife relying on the area this proposal would further take away our beautiful green belt, our village can not support such a large population with the narrow lanes, lack of parking for the shops and extremely busy road, to propose that the only way out would be down the steep road onto the main Abbey road would be dangerous, I have slipped down this road myself when collecting children and it would be a blackspot for accidents.
