Please take this email as two objections for the Banks Group proposed build of 110 houses at land in Shepley.

Our reason for objections are the impact this will have on the wildlife. In recent years we've already had two major developments in Shepley that has pushed wildlife further into the road this includes deer and bats all of which are under threat.

The build will also impact the air pollution and light pollution in Shepley and pollute the water supply with more cars, trucks, lamp posts , house lights etc...

We also have no change in infrastructure to accommodate 110 new homes. Shepley is a small village with one shop and one GP surgery that is already overstretched and one small school again at capacity.

All these reasons before you explore the proposed new road layout of making a one way road meaning people would have to come down Lea drive. This is a notorious icy and difficult to navigate road in the winter and it just is not viable.
