



- I object based on the clear detrimental impact to the health and wellbeing of the locals and visitors due to the reduction and removal of green space

The removal of trees, the green space that is utilised by many and the increased dust and pollution in the local area, during and after the build would be a clear contravention of the Council's intentions.

This is not only a green space for local residents, but also for those that visit to help their health and wellbeing which would be removed.

- I also object based on the detrimental impact to the local business of Shepley Spring, which is one of the Kirklees Top 100 and this impacts all their employees;

The need to provide jobs and support local businesses is a clear part of the Council's strategy which this application clearly contravenes.

- I further object due to the lack of infrastructure to support this proposal with already congested roads, pollution and regular occurrences of accidents as a result of the current levels of congestion that this will add;

The lack of thought to the infrastructure is evident, but the lack of capacity to support the new residents at the local GP, Dental Practices and School is even more certain as they are all already over capacity.
