I strongly object to the proposed development on the following grounds .

Environmental, the proposed land is currently greenspace acting as a lung to the village. Building upon it threatens the air quality and the business know as Shepley water works. Not least the wildlife and roofing straw.

I purchased my home in order to live in a village, not within an urban sprawl.

- Overdevelopment. Shepley is currently contributing over 100 houses to the housing stock. Enough for the next 10 years. There are currently three more housebuilding sites in the village with many unsold new houses.

The planned access and exits are not workable, in the winter the access route becomes blocked and the exit down Lea drive is dangerous. No one currently uses that route if there is snow/ice

Lea drive and its surrounds are stretched to capacity with much pavement parking making it impossible for elderly residents and children to walk safely.

The village lacks parking spaces and there is a lot of on pavement parking, on the Knowle, Lea drive, Marsh Lane and Station rd., plus the A629. The centre of the village around the COOP is regularly blocked because of parked cars.

Healthcare provision is inadequate in the village with many residents going directly to A&E rather than waiting for an appointment at the surgery.

Local school provision is inadequate, two of my near neighbours have children travelling to schools in neighbouring villages because there are no vacancies at Shepley junior school.

Virtually the hole route from Shepley to Huddersfield is now built up or will be when the current developments are finished.
