Good Afternoon,

As a long standing resident of Shepley village, I would like to object to the above planning application for the following reasons:-

The village has grown considerably in recent years, and I feel that the roads are not suitable for further housing.

I recently had a problem with water supply into my property, which when fixed highlighted the fact that they are from the Victorian times so will struggle further with more housing development.

The access to the site I do not feel is suitable for the amount of houses proposed and the number of cars that would bring.

The increase in traffic would pose a danger to children walking to the first school and through the village centre itself.

The proposal states that the village has a train station, however there is no parking at the station and access to the platforms is not easy unless able bodied. The lack of parking could result in even more parking and congested roads in what is already a busy village.

The proposal also states that there is a bus service in and from the village however this is not very regular and finishes early on an evening so would not be ideal for commuters. This therefore means cars would be required.

It also states that the village has a supermarket, this is incorrect as it is a convenience store.
