<p>My reasons for the objection are</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The facilities in the village are already overstretched. The streets in the village are already overcrowded and parking is a nightmare around the village shop which is not a supermarket and the access to the School from Lea Drive is already very busy during term time. This will cause problems for people trying to leave the area by car. The Doctors surgery is extremely busy.2. Increased traffic on Abbey Road. The crossing on Abbey Road used by School children is already difficult at peak times, more traffic will increase the dangers.3. Poor public transport. Villagers are already having to use their cars because the train service is unreliable,4. Not enough local businesses to support more local employment opportunities, meaning that new residents will have to travel outside the village.5. The effect this development will have on our local business Shepley Spring, with possible contamination of the spring water supply.6. I believe Yorkshire water have made no provision for extra houses. Housing should built near employment areas, so that people don't need to travel far. This reduces the carbon footprint and causes less stress on our overstretched road network.
