



I object to the application for the following reasons.

Traffic, the scheme as proposed cannot work, the access is too narrow and blocks every winter with stranded vehicles. The Lea drive exit onto the A629 is impossible in Ice /snow. its too dangerous and is impassable.

Parking, there is no public parking available in Shepley and Lea drive pavements are often blocked each by cars parked on the pavements.

The elderly and children have to walk on the road which is dangerous, there have been several minor accidents because of parking on pavements.

The sightline out of Lea drive onto the A629 is obscured by parking making it dangerous.

Environmental, the proposed land has for years been used to produce thatching straw, this plan will stop that. Shepley Spring waterworks may close, threatening jobs and the livelihood

and wellbeing of the community, this must not be allowed to happen. The village will loose wildlife and habitat.

Overdevelopment, Shepley is already overdeveloped with 100 houses + added in recent years, the village amenities and services are completely inadequate. Houses have been built but no new amenities, schools

or Health or recreational facilities have been added. Children living within sight of the school are currently travelling to other villages because the school is full. The Health centre is overstretched and residents have to Wait three weeks or more for non urgent appointments.

Shepley and Shelley are now joined, and virtually the whole of the south side of the A629 into Huddersfield is developed. are we to become a suburb ?

There is no need for more houses in Shepley as there are currently three developments with many unsold properties.
