The following are my objections to this planning proposal:

1. Added congestion to Eastfield and Lea Drive. These are narrow roads with on street parking especially at school time.
2. Any proposal for a one way system from Lea Drive to Abbey Road will cause increased hazards for any driver. This again is a narrow road with cars parked on the street. In icy conditions it can be very dangerous going down the road and having had a near miss myself.
