The CO-OP is the only convenience store/food vendor in the area. It does not have the extensive range of a supermarket but it is incredibly busy especially in the early evenings. There is no place to park up and the busy junction between Station Road and Marsh Lane is thronged with traffic approaching and exiting in search of a stopping place especially in the early evening.

There are three bus routes that pass complicating these traffic issues. I can only foresee the current hazardous situation becoming worse with the completion of other developments currently being constructed on Abbey Road. The proposed development will only project this situation into "an accident waiting to happen".
