I am writing to object to the proposed Eastfield Development in Shepley.

I have been a neighbouring village Shelley resident for 26 years, and this proposed development is quite alarming to me as, as well as having direct impact to the Shepley villagers, it would also affect Shelley residents.

The reasons for my objections are-

- The traffic volume already exists between the two villages is high, adding another 110 houses and 2-300 cars and hundred of thousands of extra car journeys to a small area is dangerous.
- The Shepley doctors surgery is already at full capacity, getting non urgent appointments is already problematic.
- Can the current schools accommodate the increase in school age children?
- Can the current local infrastructure cope with a big increase in demand?
- Shepley Spring, a very important business and employer for the area, how can they be protected from damage/pollutants during and after built which can destroy their business?
- Shepley will be negatively impacted as a village. With the building of even more houses and the loss of green belt spaces, Shepley and Shelley is at risk of being forcibly rolled into one and both losing their own unique identities and characteristics.
