Thank you for the email of the 24th of November 2025.

Thank you for consulting the West Yorkshire Archaeology Advisory Service (WYAAS) regarding the submission of the Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) for the above site.


Since 1st of April 2011, in accordance with an agreement of the Council Committee that oversees our work, WYAAS charges a fee for the validation, review, and monitoring of archaeological schemes.

I have attempted to contact the archaeological consultant directly to request the necessary Purchase Order (PO) to cover this fee, but this matter remains unresolved.

I am unable to undertake the technical review or formally validate the WSI.

Consequently, the pre-commencement requirement of Condition 7 has not yet been met. The condition cannot be discharged (partially or otherwise) until the WSI has been properly validated and approved in writing by WYAAS.

As soon as WYAAS have received a PO for the sum of £164 we will proceed with the review.
