I object the planned proposal of changing the above property into a children's care home.

The care home will bring in a lot of traffic and vehicles into the residential street. There isn't sufficient parking at times never mind with the daily influx of cars into the property and street. Although there is sufficient parking for two cars outside the property there may be an increased need for more than 2 vehicles at a time including when visitors are in and in case of emergencies.
