| <p>I would like to make an objection to the proposed increase in height of the wind turbine located at the former Holgate site Barnsley Road Grange Moor WF44DR as it is located only 150 yards from our house and garden. The original turbine was only approved on appeal by someone looking at a plan in an office miles away from our community, the local planning committee that viewed the site rejected it unanimously due to its close proximity to our homes. The existing smaller turbine causes severe flickering and at moderate wind speeds is very noisy, at times it can sound like a helicopter in our garden and conservatory. The specification may look ok on paper but when you live with these turbines noise and flickering daily at the coal face it's very different. The previous owner only sited it there because i had complained about the massive eyesore along with stone crushing and sand blasting in the open at the side of our homes. We would have hoped that the new owner of the site would be more sympathetic to his neighbours, we have already been subjected by default of the last owners misuse of the site to the largest industrial building in the area on a green belt site right outside our small community's homes. My has recently been diagnosed with and our conservatory with floor to ceiling windows and patio are our places of piece and joy whist going through , and I would appeal hopefully to the owners better nature and decency to either site the new turbine on the edge of the coppice of trees on the site, or even at the very south west corner of the site where it wouldn't cause harm to our residential amenities.
