


PROPOSED FRONT ELEVATION Scale 1:100









PROPOSED ROOF PLAN Scale 1:100



PROPOSED GROUND FLOOR PLAN Scale 1:50




PROPOSED FIRST FLOOR PLAN Scale 1:50




EXISTING FIRST FLOOR PLAN Scale 1:100


