Dear Planning Department,

Application to erect a 12m protective net on the boundary of Gomersal Cricket Club and 161 Oxford Road

I am writing to submit an application to install a protective net between the boundary of Gomersal Cricket Club and the neighbouring property to the south of the field, 161 Oxford Road. Both parties are in agreement to the erection of the net as proven in the attached correspondence.

During the cricket season (April to September) it is a regular occurrence for cricket balls to be hit into the garden of 161 Oxford Road, which is currently only protected by a 2m high timber fence. During the season, it is hard for the neighbours to use their rear garden whilst a game is being played due to the risk of being struck by a ball. The proposed protective net would alleviate these concerns and contribute greatly to their safety.

The cricket club has previously installed high nets on the eastern boundary along Oxford Road and more recently on the western boundary to protect the neighbouring houses along Oxford Drive. The proposed net will aim to match the existing net aesthetically as well as offering the same level of protection to neighbouring residents.
