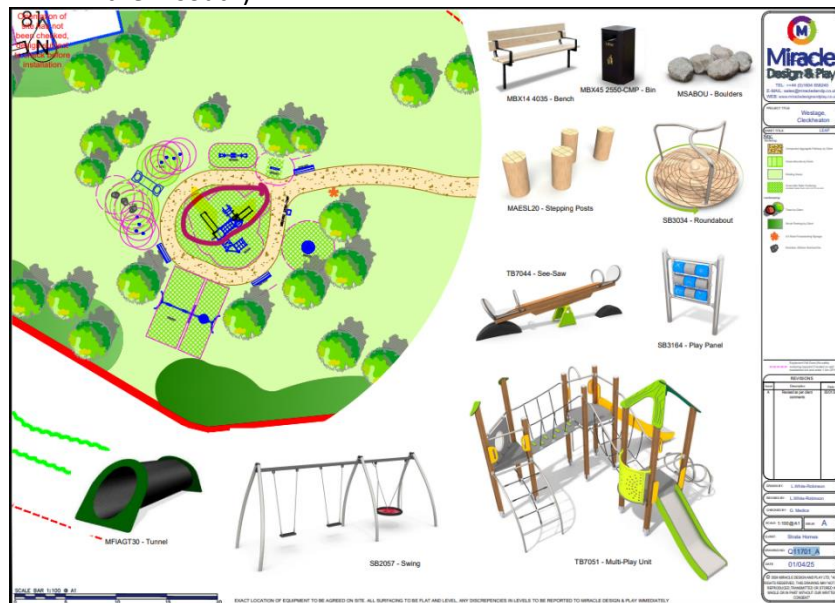
**NOTES/COMMENTS: COND 41 LEAP:**

41. Prior to the occupation of the hereby approved dwellings or works associated with the delivery of the Local Equipped Area of Play (LEAP) as shown on plan ref. "R/2487/1 Rev. L" commencing, a scheme providing details of the play equipment to be installed within the LEAP shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The details shall include a timescale for the implementation of the play equipment. The approved scheme shall be fully implemented in accordance with the timescale and be so retained thereafter.

**Reason:** To ensure adequate provision of equipment, in accordance with Policy LP63 of the Kirklees Local Plan.

Aside from our ongoing concern about the slide orientation, specifically the north-facing slides, (which are more prone to dew, frost, and slower drying) it looks like they have acknowledged and addressed the other points we raised.

1. If the climbing frame unit were pivoted clockwise 90 degrees to face east (rather than north), both the slides would benefit from early sun exposure from the east, helping them dry out sooner without their metal surfaces overheating in the midday or afternoon sun (so don't face them south).



2. The Condition requires a timescale for the implementation of the play equipment – is this confirmed anywhere?

**NOTES/COMMENTS: COND 41 LEAP:**

41. Prior to the occupation of the hereby approved dwellings or works associated with the delivery of the Local Equipped Area of Play (LEAP) as shown on plan ref. "R/2487/1 Rev. L" commencing, a scheme providing details of the play equipment to be installed within the LEAP shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The details shall include a timescale for the implementation of the play equipment. The approved scheme shall be fully implemented in accordance with the timescale and be so retained thereafter.

**Reason:** To ensure adequate provision of equipment, in accordance with Policy LP63 of the Kirklees Local Plan.
