Objection to planned children's home at no 1a Lydgate Drive, Lepton, Huddersfield, HD80EN

Please find below our Objections to the proposed children's residential home as per above application number.

Traffic and Parking issues

Lydgate Drive is a small street. When vehicles do not park on their drives it can be very tight to manoeuvre especially when delivery vehicles are present. If the proposed home goes ahead it would be a bigger problem with more vehicles being parked outside no 1a. Also, cars turning into Lydgate Drive from Wakefield Road on that section could encounter a lot of congestion right at the end of the street outside no 1a

Existing Residents on Lydgate Drive

Lydgate Drive is a quiet road with many of the residents being mainly pensioners or families with children. If the home goes ahead, and depending on the nature of the residents of the children's home, this could be a huge worry to the existing residents of Lydgate Drive and especially if the curfew is breached.

Reading the proposed manifesto there will be more traffic issues when friends and family visit and if a child did manage to get out of the home unnoticed they could end up on the very busy Wakefield road.

In summary it is a very dangerous place to have a children's residential care home
