<p>I am writing to formally object to the planning application referenced above. My primary concern is the impact the proposal will have on parking availability and the associated issues for local residents. The proposed development does not provide sufficient parking spaces to meet the needs, the application suggests that there are four parking spaces (which there clearly isn't), four spaces will not be adequate for the proposal, several staff and change over times, plus visitors may lead to several vehicles parking on the road side. The additional strain on the existing infrastructure could cause significant problems , such as increased congestion, causing unsafe parking and a safety hazard for both pedestrians and drivers entering and exiting Lydgate drive and Wakefield road. The lack of adequate parking could obstructed emergency vehicles, making it difficult for them to access properties in the event of an emergency. additional the increased traffic congestion could lead to more traffic accidents especially as Lydgate drive is narrow. The proposed plan could negatively impact local residents of which most are older/retired people, noise and disturbance could also impact on property values.</p> <p>In light of the issues outlined above I respectfully urge the planning committee to consider these concerns before making any decisions on the application.</p>
