<p>Firstly number 1a was constructed within the garden of number 1 and therefore has shown a dramatic increase in the amount of vehicles parked at the end of our quiet street.</p> <p>There are currently at least two large vehicles parked outside number 1a, as you can imagine any further vehicular visiting traffic will make it difficult exiting or entering our small crescent, especially as Wakefield road is very busy.</p> <p>Secondly it is stated that the building is to be electronically locked and that a curfew will be enforced. This suggests that the children being housed at the home obviously may need extra support.</p> <p>The majority of people living on this quiet residential road are elderly people and I don't like the idea of any noisy commercial installation being allowed on our road.</p> <p>It's mainly the issue of visiting parties, e.g. delivery vehicles, police, families, social staff and the list goes on.</p> <p>Finally the question arises "why has planning procedures and notifications on lamp posts not been implemented and displayed for residents to offer their thoughts and opinions?"</p> <p>Secondly "why was there no open and close date on the application?" We as residents had to contact the "planning department" to raise this question and was told it must have been a mistake, which is somewhat concerning when it has been noted that the same planning officer and planning agent, previously passed through the same type of application in Dalton (October 2025) and again there was no open and close dates available for residents to comment</p>
