<p>Formal objection to application 2025/93355 Woodward Court/Hepworth Lane. Building 75 houses in this area will increase the traffic on Hepworth Lane and Wellhouse Lane. Both these road have sections that are no more than 1 car width wide and they have no pavement. As these roads are both used by Children walking to school and back the increase in traffic on these roads due to these new houses would significantly increase the risk of a child been involved in a road traffic accident. Local Dentists, Doctor and Schools are already over subscribed so increase the local population would make this situation even more acute.</p> <p>Loosing this green space would be detrimental to the habitat of local wild life such as bats which are regularly seen flying over these fields.</p> <p>Extra drainage from 75 houses in this area would add more problems to the already poor drainage in the surrounding housing. There are already frequent calls for help with drainage issues. Also the land on the proposed site does not drain well with seepage appearing through the retaining walls of Hepworth Close.</p> <p>The road out of the development into Hepworth Lane is adjacent to a footpath which crosses Hepworth Line and continues in both directions. This is used by children going to and from school.</p> <p>The plan only allows for park for 112 Vehicle, but 75 houses is more than likely to bring a lot more that 112 vehicles.</p> <p>Applications to build on these fields have previously be rejected on several occasions and this application offers no difference to before. In fact it has even more houses.</p>
