| <p>I wish to object to the proposed building of houses on the land off Woodward Court and Hepworth Lane. Having lived in this area I am fully aware of how this proposed development would affect the area negatively. Life would be intolerable for residents of Woodward Court, Hepworth Lane and Wellhouse Lane. Wellhouse Lane is known as a no go area during school pick up and drop off times as well as after school events and parents evening. The end of Wellhouse Lane joining Flash Lane is very narrow and will cause congestion problems. I have experienced a broken wing mirror whilst driving on this section due to a car pushing though when there is not enough room for two vehicles. Woodward Court is a small cul-de-sac not built to accommodate such an influx of vehicles which this development would bring. Having a second entrance/exit on Hepworth Lane is an equally unsuitable area for extra vehicles due to the narrow one way route at Wellhouse Lane and the narrow access on to Shillbank Lane with bad vehicular visibility. These roads around the proposed site are totally unsuitable for such a large development. Schools in the area are already oversubscribed and further pressure would be placed on the doctors surgery. This is an unwanted development which would cause misery to all surrounding residents.</p> | |
