<p>I strongly object to the planned development of 75 residential dwellings planning application 2025/93355. My reasons are as follows.</p> <p>The safety aspect - more houses mean more two car families who will be adding to the overly congested roads. From top to bottom Wellhouse Lane is extremely narrow, and the entrance and exit on Hepworth Lane is already dangerous. There are no pavements at all at one end and walking here is an accident waiting to happen. At school arrival and finish times the traffic is horrendous, cars mount the pavement to pass each other obviously causing danger to pedestrians. Bellway Homes seem to think the traffic volume has decreased in this area - absolute nonsense. As someone who regularly uses this route I have seen first hand the amount of traffic. They have suggested a second entrance/exit from Hepworth Lane. This will not solve anything, the mass of traffic is far too high.</p> <p>We are a semi rural area. The greenbelt land is at a premium, wildlife is in danger, and biodiversity is affected. This should be preserved at cost. Kirklees may have plans regarding the housing shortage and have a quota to meet. Go look for brownfield sites where nature will not be harmed. Regenerate do not destroy!!!</p> <p>Our town can no longer support more people our health centre is oversubscribed, as are the local schools. Roadworks are a constant in this area, the infrastructure cannot cope.</p> <p>As a Mirfield resident who has lived in this area all her life, watching it's decline is heart breaking. Enough is enough!</p>
