<p>As a resident of the Dunbottle Lane area of Mirfield for over 30 years I wish to formally object to the proposed Bellway Homes plan to build 75 dwellings on the land off Woodward Court and Hepworth Lane. My reasons being as follows :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The access is woefully unsuitable and unsafe due to the widths of the roads involved and the vehicles which are parked on them. The junctions at Wellhouse Lane and Flash Lane especially as there is only room for one vehicle at a time either in or out. This causes a traffic tailback and gridlocked traffic onto Dunbottle Lane which stretches in both directions and leads to yet more driver frustrations. Adding to this, the development being so close to an infant and junior school surely will end up becoming an accident black spot due to many parked vehicles on a narrow lane.2. The infrastructure is not there. Overcrowded schools and only one GP surgery in Mirfield, and no space left to build another one it is not sustainable.3. The risk of flooding. Not a great deal of money has been spent by the water company on upgrading aging sewerage systems surely by adding more houses this will only make matters worse.4. We have very few green spaces left in Mirfield what about the wildlife and biodiversity is that being taken into account. The field should be left as it is, an open space or better still be turned into a country park to encourage yet more wildlife, flora and fauna into the area, with more tree planting for the good and benefit of the local community. <p>This application has been refused before and I certainly hope the council will see sense and turn this application down once and for all.
