<p>I write in connection with the above planning application. I know the site well and wish to object strongly to this development in this location for the following reasons.</p> <p>Mirfield does not have the right infrastructure to support this overdevelopment.</p> <p>I am resident in Wellhouse Lane and deal with heavy traffic congestion during school term times. The road is often gridlocked with emergency vehicles unable to get through. The pavements such as there are, are usually used for parking on. There are pavements only on both sides of the road north of the school with one side only lower down as far as Flash Lane. There are no pavements at the top or the bottom of Hepworth Lane. Students aged between 4 to 11 are accessing the Junior and Infant School via these 'pavements' which already poses a great risk due to cars parking and manoeuvring over the pavements without the development.</p> <p>The access and exit via Woodward Court is dangerous being grid locked at school time.</p> <p>In addition, Mirfield schools are full to capacity and the Health Centre is full to capacity.</p> <p>The surrounding road network is unchanged since the 1950's and all in need of repair. Greenside road is already narrow with residents parked down one side due to limited parking. It is also a bus route and becomes easily congested.</p> <p>I support Save Mirfield's representation on this planning application as I share it's concerns.</p> <p>I urge the Council to refuse planning permission.</p>
