<p>I wish to object to application 2025/93355.</p> <p>I have a considerable history of using Wellhouse Lane as a pedestrian. For over 20 years I looked after children whom I walked to and from the school from my home on Wellhouse Lane. The road then was badly congested at school arrival and turning out times. Cars mounted the pavements to reach the school. I experienced this, having to protect the children with me from a car driving along the pavement towards us.</p> <p>75 new houses, many with children who will be attending Crossley Fields Junior and Infant school on Wellhouse Lane cannot fail to add to the congestion. Cars are parked along the road sometimes for half an hour with their engines left running.</p> <p>Wellhouse Lane leading onto Flash Lane is very narrow at this point with no or negligible pavement space. The road connecting Hepworth Lane to Wellhouse Lane is also very narrow with no pavements on either side.</p> <p>Woodward Court emerges onto Wellhouse Lane on a bend in the road very close to the school. Thus any extra traffic produced by this housing development will pose more danger to children coming to and from school.</p> <p>I feel that the fields earmarked for development under the new housing plan provide a very welcome green space for the people living on Hepworth Lane and Drive and also for other people living in the area.</p> <p>I walked my dog around those fields on the footpaths and appreciated the fact that they were there.</p>
