I am totally against the planning for new development of housing :

As a resident of 43 Hepworth Lane Mirfield I am really concerned about additional traffic, safety of pedestrians and that of the school children who use Hepworth Lane as a route to school and home.

Hepworth Lane has minimal footpaths due to the narrow width of the road there is no room to improve it.

Getting out of my drive at any time of day is Russian roulette in no small part, as the mouth of the entrance to Hepworth Lane is so narrow vehicle cross the centre line just to turn in.

Also this route is used heavily by parents and families including numerous prams on a daily basis and due to the footpath issue have to walk on the road. Their safety will be compromised if the approval was given.

Flash Lane is already a race track to Ravensthorpe. Additional traffic from 75 new homes, which I estimate would exceed 100 vehicles would just create more congestion, disturbance and vastly increase risk for incident with either vehicle collision or God forbid personal injury or worse.

It is my opinion that the only conclusion that can be reached, with clear conscience is to deny this application on the grounds of safety, residential disruption and hopefully, common sense
