<p>I live on Wellhouse Lane next to Crossley Fields school and regularly witness the congestion and havoc caused by the school traffic. I can only imagine that building further houses in this area as per planning application will add to the current problems. Parents vehicles conveying children out of the new development to schools elsewhere (I assume that not all children living in the new properties would either get into Crossley fields or want to go there) thus adding to the twice a day mayhem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Child safety if constantly under threat by aggressive drivers delivering and picking up children from the school- regular aggressive arguments and behaviour take place- I have monitored the traffic flow at school times with journey numbers regularly exceeding >200 vehicles- Wellhouse Lane and Hepworth lane cannot cope with increased traffic due to the narrow nature of the roads in certain areas- I suspect that the residents of the new development would experience their parking and access disrupted by parents using the development as a parking area causing further conflict- On a personal front the new development would almost certainly condemn me to living the rest of my days in my current house. When we tried to sell about 5 years ago people liked the house but not the proximity to the school and associated problems. The new development would further dilute my chances of ever moving.
