<p>I wish to formally object to application2025/93355.</p> <p>Hepworth Lane is very very narrow and cannot possibly accommodate the traffic which this development would generate especially at the point of entry and exit from Flash Lane and Shillbank Lane.Two cars cannot pass in places and a lack of footpaths makes it dangerous for pedestrians. School children use this road and a development of this magnitude would impact on their safety. Children's safety is paramount.</p> <p>Beltway homes has tried to get planning permission on several occasions and planning has been refused, what makes you think planning can be granted this time.</p> <p>If an entrance were to be made at Woodward Court then traffic would come onto Wellhouse Lane which is narrow and with cars parked on one side permanently the Lane is more or less single file traffic at all times of the day.</p> <p>We are so short of doctors in this country and to put pressure on the existing resources is unfair on the medical staff and patients who are already registered at the practice.
