<p>I formally object to the planning application for reasons as follows: It would be unsafe on Hepworth lane as its one-way and doesn't have a footpath in some areas and there is no way of widening the road. Parents taking their children to and from school would be at risk of being involved in an RTC. On Wellhouse Lane, cars already have to take turns to pass parked vehicles and parts are so narrow that cars come on to the pavement. Same applies to Flash Lane which is a busy thoroughfare already. With more traffic on these narrow roads this is an accident waiting to happen. The current infrastructure would not able to take the added strain. Also, the extra traffic would be detrimental to local residents health and wellbeing exacerbated by the removal of the trees and green fields. None of the proposed access roads are suitable for dealing with the additional traffic, reducing the impact on existing residents or mitigating current school traffic. I do not think anything has changed substantially from previous applications and there has been no cognisance taken of existing mine workings etc.</p>
