Has anyone from the planning department seen the state of traffic on these lanes, Wellhouse lane is frequently blocked and Crossley Lane is a proper country lane, all these lanes converge on one another. Also where is the infrastructure coming from, it's already a nightmare trying to get a doctors appointment, this will affect everyone in Mirfield not just the immediate area. Two weeks ago bins could not be emptied certainly on some part of Wellhouse lane because of parked cars on the road and the dustbin wagon couldn't get through, people with wheelchairs or pushchairs can't get passed when cars are on the pavement, these lanes are definitely over loaded with cars already never mind possibly s is another 130/150 converging on these lanes, this is something which should be taken seriously.</p>
