<p>I would like to formally object to this application.</p> <p>The land with proposed planning is precious green belt land in our area. Mirfield has little left due to planning allowed when brown sites could be purchased &amp; built on instead. The area here is plagued by speeding drivers &amp; "rat runs" used to cut corners, making walking or driving more challenging &amp; definitely less enjoyable. Twice daily the roads are already gridlocked with parents waiting to collect their children.
