<p>I hereby object to this application. I attended the meeting in Mirfield, studied the plans and spoke to a few people involved from Bellway, including their legal representation. I left disheartened as it became very clear that they were going through the motions and were here for damage limitation, not because they wanted to HEAR our reasons. I live on Crossley Lane in bungalow right next to the school. The second access road for the development comes out further down the lane where it is very narrow. Two cars cannot pass but have to try and move into the bushes and get your car scratched. The people who bring children to the school in cars used to park at the front of school, but double yellow lines stopped that and they all now park ON CROSSLEY LANE at the rear and take the pubic footpath down the side of my property and garden. Rubbish is tossed in my garden but worse is that i cannot go on to any appointments etc if i return at school time as my is parked in at times so i cant get home. I have been physically threatened by mothers who just feel they can do as they want to get their children. They park both sides of the narrow lane leaving a narrow space. Then we have the farm vehicles from the farm just a few yards up the road. Tractors and heavy farm machinery, all those cars, children, dog walkers and the horse riders from the Equestrian Centre at the back of the school is a recipe for disaster. At the back of the school we are all bungalows. I have had 2 cars written off completely and 2 others needing repairs. All of which no one owns up to. The lane (CROSSLEY LANE) is where all these cars will come out onto and the small country lane can JUST accommodate the traffic we have now. Bellway have been refused planning permission more than once for these objections but are determined to get it despite those of us who live here. The legal rep or someone from Bellway at the meeting said to me " well 20 of those houses are allocated to Kirklees for social housing" as a if to say "so kirklees are bound to pass it because they are getting something"</p> <p>I was furious. Those previous objections that stopped previous applications havent gone away. So the only thing they have different is they are "giving housing to Kirklees to fullfill their Government Quota". This is going to be interesting</p>
