<p>I live on flash lane however entrance to the rear of my property is accessed on the narrowest part of Hepworth Lane, the rear gate to my property sits virtually on the lane, this means when you step out of the gate you are directly into the road as there is no pavement. We have lived in the property for around 20 years and over time traffic on the lane has increased dramatically, there is many reasons for this residents have more than one car/home deliveries/online deliveries and in addition to this more and more parents driving their children to school as they use Hepworth lane as a cut through onto wellhouse lane, we frequently enter our property at the rear to gain access to our vehicles, each time we step out it feels like you are taking your life into your own hands and pot luck whether you get hit by a car or not due to the amount of cars and speed some people drive up the lane !</p> <p>Neither hepworth lane or wellhouse lane can take anymore traffic at anytime of the day but especially school time, my elderly parent lives at the top of wellhouse lane and I avoid school times to visit as you can't get anyway near, what should be a two minute drive from my property at school times is a fifteen minute drive so goodness knows what would happen if I had to get there in an emergency ! If the road was opened up between Woodward court and Hepworth lane drivers/ parents would use it as a cut through which would create more traffic on Hepworth lane at school drop off and pick up time which would cause gridlock around all the surrounding areas !</p> <p>I think this building proposal is a crazy idea and if it gets passed it is an accident/fatality waiting to happen !</p>
