I wish to raise further objections following amendments to the proposal.

Placing yellow lines and an island around Woodward court and wellhouse lane would not in any way remedy the volume of traffic in this area and would not reduce the risk of traffic accidents potentially involving school children.

School traffic would park further down wellhouse lane and therefore cause high risk to pedestrians navigating a narrow road.

The issues raised for Hepworth road have remained unchanged as it is a very narrow road (one car width in places) and does not have a pavement in places. Any additional traffic can only increase the risk of accidents.

Kirklees MC have a duty of care for the safety and wellbeing of its residents and in particular children. Allowing this development to go ahead would contravene its policies.
