To whom it may concern,

I'm emailing to note my objections to the proposed planning,

The traffic and parked cars are already a real hazard for residents, stemming from the school and sports activities, and at school run times already pose a huge safety hazard, as well as being a real nuisance. Adding in the extra traffic from the development would be extremely harmful and adding Hepworth lane as an exit only point is ridiculous - it is not suitable or fit for purpose and dangerous.

The proposed changes do not mitigate or reflect the real experience of living here, they don't address traffic volume or safety. The main problem is the volume of the traffic, not the speed at which it's going. It is already going very slowly due to the immense numbers of cars. For those trying to turn in at the bottom of flash lane during rush hours, it's often impossible due to the volume of traffic and my husband has had to get out of his car, stop traffic further up from continuing down, so people are able to turn in and access their homes. As there's such a narrow space. Suitable for just 1 car.

There is already limited parking, and some of these proposed measures will harm residents and their visitors without making any actual difference.

The roads are already unfit for purpose, being so narrow, so adding extra traffic onto them is just totally unsuitable.

I hope you will take this into consideration when making your decision.
