I expressed my objection previously and wish to do so again.

This proposed development should not go ahead. Mirfield is gridlocked on a daily basis so building another 75 houses is utterly ridiculous. The road infrastructure surrounding the proposed site is certainly NOT adequate for the extra vehicles it would generate. The roads are narrow and there is already extra traffic due to the close proximity to the local primary school and the amount of out of area children who go to that school. It is dangerous enough for pedestrians, and for the residents of Wellhouse Lane and Hepworth Lane without allowing all the extra vehicles, plus the heavy plant involved in the construction of the proposed development!

The suggestion that speed humps and yellow lines will solve the problem is incomprehensible! It would just push the problem of parked vehicles/school traffic elsewhere.

I would reiterate that this planning application should most certainly been opposed!
