As a resident of Woodward Court I find it laughable that Bellway think that adding a few speed bumps and yellow lines will alleviate the traffic problem in the Wellhouse Lane and Woodward Court area.

The proposal of a yellow line on one side of the Court will do nothing to stop the cars that are parked before and after school. Presently we have to endure with cars parked in front of and even sometimes on driveways. All we get from the parents is a mouth full of abuse. Cars start parking for afternoon pick up from 2pm!
